INTRODUCING UNITED 2017

United 2017 is a one-day conference in Asbury Park, NJ, on Sunday, April 30, 2017, produced by Jersey Pride, Inc. and Garden State Equality. The conference is intended to support the resistance that is forming throughout the country and channel it into activism here in New Jersey. Specifically, this conference will help train new activists on advocacy, provide tools and resources to enable all attendees to take their next activism steps, and allow networking and social-capital building between attendees. Attendees will be encouraged and inspired – encouraged that there are actions they can take and that they are not alone in what they are experiencing... and inspired as to the range of actions (advocacy, resistance, response, community building, smart language, resilience) available to them.

PRESENTERS

This conference will showcase presenters who have made a difference in their communities. We are asking that they share their experiences and help attendees understand and imagine what is possible. Right now, hundreds of thousands of people watch the daily news and think to themselves, “No way. That cannot happen. I won’t let that happen.” Day after day we witness assaults on the environment, our education and health care systems, the arts, and women’s right to choose, attacks on transgendered people and people of color, vandalism of LGBTQ establishments, and violations of the civil rights of American citizens and immigrants. Concerned individuals are taking action, and many more would if they knew what actions to take. United 2017 is a much-needed resource for direction and solidarity.

We are offering attendees four 50 minute-sessions during the day, each with four concurrent presentations. These can be structured as multi-presenter panels or individual presentations. We encourage presenters to include in their presentations actions that attendees can take – either during the presentation or once they leave – to empower them and reinforce the message and content of the presentation. Our goal is for attendees to leave the conference with an understanding of and confidence in the following.

- How to engage with the activism community
- How to prioritize issues that they feel strongly about
- How to use and interpret messaging and language

 4. If you need AV equipment, please let us know and our IT team will work with you to ensure you are able to present appropriately at the conference. Note you must notify us in advance to ensure we have the equipment that you need.
 5. We will be including a brief description of it, including a presenter bio, on our website, in the conference program, and on our registration page.
